Sally Davis Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:30 am, with Stephen Shaughnessy and Shelly Garber present.

1. December minutes were approved as written.
2. Sally received a letter from the Selectmen, regarding DES, and alteration of a berm in the stream called Mill Brook, lot 8/7-1.
3. DES has notified us of a illegal stream crossing, DES #2012-03337.
4. We received a letter from the attorneys Deachman and Cowie, responding to a concern of the dry hydrant on Mill Brook Road, DES # 2007-02503.
5. Sally informed the committee of Plymouth upgrading their street lighting to LED, from 400w to 150w, and from a 10 year life, to a 20 year life.
6. Nobis Engineering's wetland scientist, Alden Beauch, outlined the proposed project in Waterville Estates, for road construction to access the new wells to be used for a supply of domestic water in the development. DES will be notified for proper permitting.
