At the meetings and public hearing held on December 20, 2018 and January 17, 2019, and taking into consideration the application submitted as reflected in the minutes of said meetings and hearing, the Thornton Planning Board issues this permit as required by the **Thornton Excavation Regulations** and **NH RSA 155-E**.

Approval is based upon the submitted application materials including the grading and restoration plan(s) which have been reviewed by the Thornton Planning Board as well as the testimony from the applicant, applicant's agent and four (4) abutters and/or other residents. Excavation operation shall comply with the approved application and all associated conditions as well as **RSA 155-E**. Changes in the plan will require an official amendment of this permit. The excavation operation may be visited and reviewed annually to assure compliance with this permit.

Pursuant to **RSA 155-E:10** – The regulator or its duly authorized agent may suspend or revoke the permit of any person who has violated any provision of this permit, or this chapter, or made a material misstatement in the application upon which this permit was granted. Such suspension or revocation shall be subject to a motion for rehearing thereon and appeal in accordance with **RSA 155-E:9**.


This permit is not transferable without the prior, written approval of the Thornton Planning Board. A copy of the permit shall be prominently posted at the excavation site or the principal access thereto.

In addition to the requirements of the Thornton Excavation Regulations and RSA 155-E, there are additional conditions of this permit which are as follows:

- 1. Hours of operation:** Monday through Friday (No Sundays or Federal Holidays) 7:00 am to 5:00 pm and from 8:00 am to 12:00 Noon on Saturday.
- 2. Processing machinery:** May be erected and maintained on the property, shall be operated in conformance with the Thornton Excavation Regulations, **RSA 155: E** this application and permit issued.
- 3. Blasting:** Not allowed.
- 4. On-site storage:** Equipment may be refueled on site, but no storage of fuel is allowed on site. No storage of solid waste is allowed on site.
- 5. Water Quality:** No degradation of water quality shall be allowed to occur as a result of this excavation project.
- 6. Dust control measures:** May be required upon request by the Thornton Planning Board.
- 7. Backhauling, Importing and Storage of Material:** Earth, concrete, and asphalt that did not originate from the site may be brought in, or stored upon, temporarily and any such material shall to be processed and/or removed prior to pit closure.
- 8. Crushing:** May be done on site during stated hours of operation Monday through Friday. crushing is not permitted on Saturdays or Federal Holidays. The Planning Board reserves the right to adjust the operating hours of said crusher if necessary.
- 9. Posting of Bond/Surety:** Amount of Reclamation Bond to be posted for site is Ten Thousand Dollars (**10,000.00**) to be renewed annually by the permittee. The applicant/permittee shall be responsible to timely file the annual renewal with the town.
