If you are age 60+ or a person with a disability (and no Medicaid) you have the following transportation options:

-If you live in Bristol, Alexandria, Bridgewater, Hebron, Groton
-Bus runs Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday in the Newfound area, Friday to the Plymouth area

Plymouth Area Sr Center 536-1204

-If you live in Plymouth, Ashland, Dorchester, Groton, Campton, Holderness, Rumney, Thornton, Warren, Wentworth
-Bus runs Monday - Friday in Plymouth area

Volunteer Drivers

Our drivers are volunteers from 19 communities. They have gone through a rigorous "credentialing" process that is federally approved.

Our drivers use their own personal vehicles and are reimbursed for the mileage that they accumulate from transporting clients. We ask that all passengers are courteous and respectful to the drivers and their vehicles. Our volunteers come to us with a variety of vehicle sizes from small cars to large trucks. Please let us know if you have limitations so we can send an appropriate vehicle for your needs.
