

Thornton Transfer Station Action Committee (TSAC) - January 14, 2021 Meeting Minutes

- The meeting was conducted at the Thornton Town Hall on January 12, 2021 from 6:05 PM until 8:05 PM. Members were socially distanced in the room and wore masks.
- The meeting was also accessible via Zoom and three people called in.
- Participating in the meeting were: Steve Chiocca, Peter Laufenberg, Dan Boynton, Julie Piehn, Candy Andrews, Myrtle Lewis, Bob McCabe, Bill DeLeo, and Roy Sanbourn.
- Peter Laufenberg (Chair) started the meeting and the following items were discussed:
 - o The last TSAC meeting (November 18, 2020) minutes were approved by the Committee.
 - The Policies & Logistics Subcommittee met several times in the past two months and worked on a few drafts of the Transfer Station Ordinance. Special thanks to Bill DeLeo and Bob McCabe for their extensive background research and efforts drafting and revising the Transfer Station Ordinance.
 - The Source Reduction Committee met a few times and communicated mostly via email. They
 evaluated implementing Single Stream Recycling (not practical). They determined that the
 Towns (T/C/E) weren't ready for Pay as You Throw (PAYT) yet, maybe in a few years.
 - Allow T/C/E commercial/industrial companies to use the T.S., but they must pay higher fees.
 - Have Appendices in the Ordinance for: A Hours of Operation, B Fee Schedule and C Materials Not Accepted at the T.S.
 - Most of the discussion was directly about draft # 4 of the Ordinance. Bill DeLeo noted changes on his copy during the meeting; he will send out a copy of draft Ordinance # 5, later.
 - Changes to the Ordinance included: adding more definitions, fees if not using clear bags, the need for electronic payments, local availability of clear trash bags, temporary permits, nonresident tax payers, airbnb and VRBO rental properties, dumpsters for businesses, education and rollout for residents about upcoming changes, etc.
- The meeting was adjourned at approx. 8:05 PM.
